Instrument Discovery

Try out a range of brass and pBrass plastic instruments

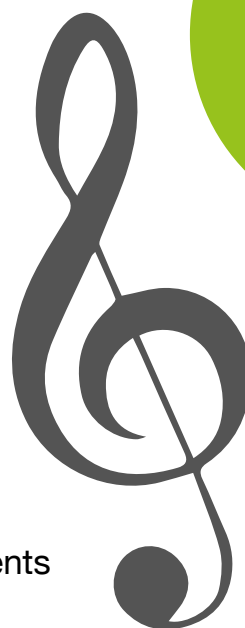
Early Years

Students will come onboard with their TA or teacher to enjoy the lighting, resources and sounds applicable to the theme. Please note LMS does not provide a teacher for this session.
